

## Sample coverage and distribution of PICS I and PICS II

### Sample Coverage

#### *Industrial Coverage*

1. PICS II uses the same sampling methodology as the original PICS in 2002 and covers establishments in the manufacturing and business support services sectors. For manufacturing industries, the economic activities are defined according to Divisions (2-digit codes) under the Malaysia Standard Industrial Classification (MSIC) 2000, which is identical to the United Nations Statistical Division's International Standard Industrial Classification of All Economic Activities (ISIC Rev. 3) up to the 4-digit level. In PICS II, 12 manufacturing industries are covered. For the business support services industries, the five categories employed in the first round of the Productivity and Investment Climate Survey (PICS I), which was conducted in 2002, are covered again in PICS II. Table A 1.5 lists the 12 manufacturing industries and 5 business support services sectors in PICS II.

#### *Geographical Coverage*

2. Following the geographical coverage of PICS I, PICS II covers 6 regions: 4 regions located in Peninsular Malaysia and 2 regions located in East Malaysia. Within each of the 6 regions, states and areas to be covered are selected based on the concentration of establishments as shown in Table A1.6.
