ABSTRACT

The Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) has developed a monitoring system in 26 food crisis countries to better understand the impacts of various shocks on agricultural livelihoods, food security and local value chains. The Monitoring System consists of primary data collected from households on a periodic basis (more or less every four months, depending on seasonality). FAO Yemen Country Office, with technical support from DIEM conducted the fourth high-frequency monitoring survey, which is focused on quick-changing indicators related to shocks and food security. Data collection took place from 14 - 24 June 2023 with 2 483 households in all 22 governorates of Yemen via Computer Assisted Telephone Interviews and using Random Digit Dialing. The sample is representative at the national and governorate level with a 95 percent confidence level and a 10 percent precision.
