ABSTRACT

The Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) through its Country Office in Yemen, with technical support from the Data in Emergencies (DIEM) Hub, conducted the eleventh round of its high-frequency monitoring (HFM) survey, marking the twentieth survey overall, to track rapidly evolving indicators related to shocks and food security. High-frequency monitoring (HFM) surveys, alternating with regular DIEM surveys, are a rapid assessment of the food security situation in Yemen aimed to support early warning and decision-making. This survey did not collect any data on crops, livestock, or need for assistance. Data collection was carried out from 4 July to 16 July 2024, reaching 2500 households across all 22 governorates of Yemen through Computer-Assisted Telephone Interviews (CATI).

Sampling

SAMPLING PROCEDURE

Initially, the sample was designed with 110 households in each of the 22 governorates, amounting to 2420 households nationally. The survey estimates are representative of the population of Yemen and the governorates (administrative level 1), with a 95 percent confidence level and a 10 percent margin of error.

DEVIATIONS FROM THE SAMPLE DESIGN

Eventually, 2500 households were interviewed, with a minimum of 113 households interviewed in each governorate. Around 55 percent of the households surveyed were engaged in crop and livestock production and sale, and only 3 percent in fishery.

WEIGHTING

Data was weighted during the analysis to ensure a proportionate representation of the population. Weights were computed based on population size and a wealth proxy (access to drinkable water and education of the head of the household).
