### ABSTRACT

The Africa Gender Innovation Lab (GIL) is partnering with Pro-International Health (PHI) to evaluate a vocational training program. This program is part of an overarching strategy implemented by Pro-Health International (PHI)— Integrated Child Health and Social Services Award (ICHSSA)— to mitigate the impact of HIV/AIDS. The targeted beneficiaries of the vocational training program are rural women residing in the states of Bauchi and Adamawa in Nigeria who are caregivers of children living with HIV (CLHIV), women with children and living with HIV (PLHIV), and caregivers of children that have been exposed to sexual violence and other abuse, as well as caregivers of HIV-exposed infants. The vocational training program seeks to impart technical skills in non-farm trades, such as tailoring, and dry and wet grinding as well as life skills such as problem-solving, collaboration and negotiation. The program also includes the provision of an asset transfer to women who complete at least 70% of the training. Alongside, PHI will also implement a buddy program - where trainees are paired together at the beginning of the program - which is designed to address women's social network constraints. Two versions of the buddy program will be tested: self-selection of peers and a random matching process

## Coverage

### GEOGRAPHIC COVERAGE

The study sample is comprised of women in 15 LGAs of Adamawa and Bauchi States in Northeast Nigeria. The LGAs were selected in both states based on rural location, logistical reasons, and low risk of insurgency. The beneficiaries were from eight (8) LGAs in Adamawa and seven (7) LGAs in Bauchi. The 8 LGAs in Adamawa state are Numan, Demsa, Fufore, Girei, Gombi, Hong, Mayo-belwa, and Song; while the 7 LGAs from Bauchi state are Bogoro, Dass, Tafawa-Balewa, Toro, Ningi, Misau, and Katagum.

### UNIVERSE

The study sampling frame includes 4,200 eligible women residing in 570 communities across 15 Local Government Areas (LGAs) out of the 21 LGAs in Adamawa and Bauchi. These 4,200 women were caregivers of children living with HIV (CLHIV), women with children and living with HIV (PLHIV), caregivers of HIV-exposed infants and children exposed to sexual violence, gender-based violence, and other abuses.
