INSTRUCTIONS: If the enterprise operates out of the home, ask to speak to the person in the home who answered questions about household spending and the materials the house is made of in the first survey round

If the enterprise operates in a separate location from the home, ask if the enterprise owner answered questions about household spending and the materials the house is made of in the first survey. If they did, you can ask these questions at the business. If they didn't and the person who did answer them is at the business location, you can also ask these questions from this person at the business location.

Otherwise, if the business is operated at a separate location from the house, and the person who answered the household questions is not at the business location, go to the house and ask these questions from the person who answered the household questions in the first round
