

Notes:

- Total sample size was 6636 respondents
- All percentages are column percentages, so they reflect the percentage of people in that column. For example, Q1.4, page 1: 344 respondents in Tshwane answered that they are very satisfied with their dwelling, which is 27.9% of the total number of respondents in Tshwane (N=1234).
- Weights were applied for all the respondents, to ensure that the sample reflects the correct proportions of the size of the municipalities throughout the sample. Due to this, rounding off takes place, which can result in some minor discrepancies between the totals and the individual responses.
- **Shaded questions numbers** are questions that are not asked to ALL the respondents, because they form part of a skip pattern, and are “not applicable”. The total number of that the percentages are based on is mentioned below each question. For example, Q1.2 on page 1: only 119 respondents in Tshwane answered this question, so the 17.6% who said “Yes” is based on the 119 respondents, and not on ALL the respondents in Tshwane.
- Recodes were done for a number of questions:
 - Education (Q12.1): recoded into “None/not specified”, “Primary” (grades 1 to 7), “Secondary” (grades 8 to 12), and “Tertiary” (any post matric qualifications).
 - Housing type (A20): recoded into “Formal” (codes 1 to 6), “Informal” (codes 7 and 8), and “other” (all other codes).
 - Employment status (Q12.3): recoded into “Employed” (codes 1 to 6), “Unemployed” (codes 7 to 8) and “Not Economically Active” (codes 9 to 13).
 - Q5.4 – Attended any meetings: recoded to reflect “Yes” (respondent has attended at least one of the meetings mentioned in Q5.4.1 to Q5.4.8) and “No” (respondent has NOT attended any meetings mentioned in Q5.4.1 to Q5.4.8).
 - Q6.9 – Satisfaction with life as a whole: recoded into “Satisfied” (codes 1 and 2 combined), “Neutral” (code 3), “Dissatisfied” (codes 4 and 5 combined).
 - Q9 – Membership of any organisations or clubs: recoded to reflect “Yes” (respondent is a member of at least one of the organisations mentioned in Section 9) and “No” (respondent is not a member of any of the organisations mentioned in Section 9).
