PARACETAM tablets (Paracetamol)

Patient information leaflet

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Dosage:

Adults - 2 tablets every 4 hours as needed. Do not take tablets at intervals shorter than 4 hours and do not exceed the dose of 8 tablets within 24 hours.

Children (6 to 12 years) - 1/2 to 1 tablet to be given every 4 hours as needed. Children should not be given more than 4 tablets within 24 hours. Children should not be given tablets for a period longer than three days without consulting a doctor. Children under 6 years of age should be given the tablets only on prescription. If symptoms persist, consult your doctor.

Do not exceed the indicated dose. Taking a high dose of the medicine can damage the liver. If you exceed the recommended dose, seek immediate medical assistance, even if you are feeling well.


