Sampling

Sampling Procedure

- Primary health care facilities: the survey targeted all 500 SURE-P MCH Phase I primary health care facilities.
- Midwives: the survey targeted 1,285 midwives enrolled (in 2013/2014) in an experiment to test the effectiveness of different form of incentives (monetary; non-monetary; combined) on midwife attrition.

Response Rate

- Midwife target: 1,285; achievement: 1,182; response rate: 99.7%
- Primary health care facility target: 500; achievement: 493; response rate: 98.6%
