## Rules for Filling in the Questioner

1. It is kindly asked to fill in the forms on a daily basis.
2. Questioner should comprise the information on those commodities, which are used in the households. Those commodities, which are in entrepreneurship or agricultural enterprises for usage, are not registered in the book.
3. The information on the expenditures and income should concern all the members of the household.
4. All varieties of the procured food products should be registered every day in Table X.1. In Table X.2 all varieties of the consumed food products shall be registered, independent of the fact whether the goods were procured, produced in the farms or received free of charge. In Tables X.1 and X.2 except eggs all other varieties should be given in measure units as in “kg”, or “liters” (e.g. bread, fish, beverages, confectionery etc). The measure unit for eggs should be in “units”
5. In Table X.3 the information on the expenditures in restaurants, cafe, and canteens should be included.
6. The costs of all chargeable services and procured industrial goods should be mentioned in Table X.4, the number of tobacco boxes has to be mentioned as well.
7. The information on any food produce or service received free of charge should be given in Table X.5, with mentioning its cost.
8. The information for Table Y.1 should be registered on the day of receiving income.
9. Those varieties of the food produce that are daily consumed in little quantities (salt, pepper, coffee) should be registered by the end of the surveyed month (table Z.2).
10. The rarely procured commodities (furniture, television) should be registered by the end of the surveyed month (in Table Z.3)
11. Interviewer: It is required to fill in Table Z.4 by the end of the surveyed month for the quantity of days that the members of the households were absent.
