- Yes/No questions: "Yes" is coded as "1," "No" is coded as "2."

Overview

ABSTRACT

The Country Opinion Survey in Guinea assists the World Bank Group (WBG) in gaining a better understanding of how stakeholders in Guinea perceive the WBG. It provides the WBG with systematic feedback from national and local governments, multilateral/bilateral agencies, media, academia, the private sector, and civil society in Guinea on:

- 1) Their views regarding the general environment in Guinea;
- 2) Their overall attitudes toward the WBG in Guinea;
- 3) Overall impressions of the WBG's effectiveness and results, knowledge work and activities, and communication and information sharing in Guinea; and
- 4) Their perceptions of the WBG's future role in Guinea.

Sampling

Sampling Procedure

From February to March 2019, 395 stakeholders of the WBG in Guinea were invited to provide their opinions on the WBG's work in the country by participating in a Country Opinion Survey. Participants were drawn from the Office of the President, Prime Minister; office of a Minister; office of a Parliamentarian; ministries/ministerial departments/implementation agencies; Project Management Units (PMUs) overseeing implementation of WBG projects; consultants/ contractors working on WBG-supported projects/programs; local governments; bilateral and multilateral agencies; private sector organizations; the financial sector/private banks; private foundations; NGOs and community-based organizations; the media; independent government institutions; trade unions; faith-based groups; youth groups; academia/research institutes/think tanks; judiciary branch; and other organizations.

Weighting

The results in this year's Country Survey were compared to those in the Country Survey conducted in FY'16 (response rate was 78%, N=384). Data were weighted to reach the same stakeholder composition in two years, which allows for year comparisons. Stakeholder groups which were not present in both fiscal years were not included in the comparison. Respondents who belonged to the "other" stakeholder category were not included either. As a result, mean ratings, percentages of respondents, and the total number of respondents in both years are slightly different from those of the original data reported in the FY'16 COS report and the non-weighted data presented in appendices A, B, C, D and F.
