


Mortality and causes of death: findings from death notifications 2013






20.6% The highest number of deaths due to transport accidents were recorded in Limpopo. Mid-year population estimates show that in 2013, roughly 10% of the total South african population lived in Limpopo.

The Northern Cape and Gauteng both accounted for 6.5% of all transport related deaths. Gauteng is the most populous province in the coutry with roughly 24% of the total population while only about 2.3% of the total population live in the Northern Cape. The Northern Cape is the biggest province in South Africa with the smallest population.

The relative contribution of deaths due to assault, compared to the overall number of deaths, is much higher in the Western and Northern Cape. 25% Mpumalanga and Limpopo showed the lowest. 20% 15% 10% 5% EC NC FS GP WC KZN NW MP LP
