Now we are going to determine how much you are willing to pay for the course. Keep in mind the following rules:

- 1) You should propose a price that you are comfortable with paying for the course. You should not propose more than what you are willing and able to pay.
- 2) You should not propose too little either since you will not be able to review your choice after you roll the dice, and then you might not be able to take the course if the price you proposed is not high enough.
- 3) The actual price you will pay will be determined by the rolling of two dice.
- 4) Before rolling the dice you will sign a commitment to pay the amount you proposed.
- 5) If the price we offer you is equal to or below that amount, we will ask you to pay today as much as you can, and you can bring the rest within a week.
