

Field Work Details for: Pesquisa sobre Ética e Corrupção no Serviço Público

The survey was conducted as a census at the federal public service level, with a total sample of 22,130 respondents, which ensures a high level of statistical confidence. Data collection took place online from April 28 to May 28, 2021 with the support of the CGU, the Ministry of the Economy, and National School of Administration (ENAP). All federal ministries were included in the survey sample. The survey instrument was Survey CTO, and the survey link was disseminated through ENAP.

The response rate was higher at the CGU (19.9 percent) and at the Ministry of the Environment (7.0 percent), while the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (1.8 percent) and the Ministry of Regional Development (1.7 percent) presented the lowest response rates. 5 All federative units were included in the sample, and the highest proportion of respondents were based in the Federal District and in Rio de Janeiro. Acre and Roraima had relatively fewer respondents, which was already expected since those states have a smaller presence of federal employees.
