












### Overall, how do you see your family's personal economic situation in Kenya?










### What is your relationship to the person who sends you a remittance?





### How frequently does your family member or relative send you money?










### How much money – on average – does your family member or relative send to you each time?









Approximately what portion of the money you receive do you spend on daily expenses such as food, clothes, housing, utilities and medicine?






